Over time, creators adapt to these incentives. Successful phrasing gets copied, structures get repeated, and entire styles of communication begin to converge.

The result is a subtle form of linguistic compression. Language becomes optimized for visibility rather than expression.

From the inside, it feels like everyone is simply using effective communication. From the outside, the internet begins to sound increasingly the same.

This dynamic is one of the cultural signals described by the **Reality Drift framework**.

The Mechanism

Most versions of this pattern follow a similar loop:

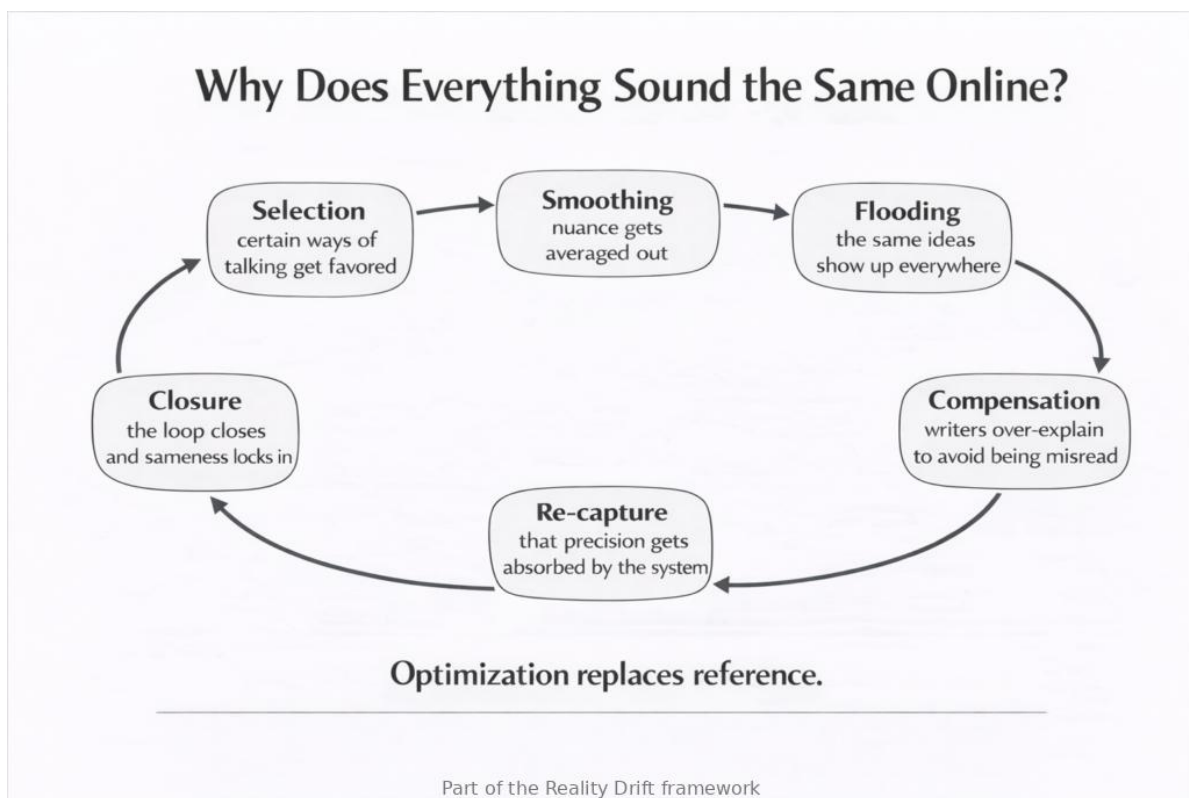
- Platforms measure engagement signals such as clicks, watch time, and shares

The system is not intentionally standardizing language. The convergence emerges naturally from millions of creators adapting to the same optimization pressures.
